Administration Team

Biblical Counselling Team

Though the Biblical Counselling Team are not trained mental health professionals, they are compassionate Christians with a big heart to listen to, pray for and walk alongside those in need, pointing them to the help available to us in Jesus.

Events Team

Part of the way we seek to do this is through the running of great events. Each year the Events Team helps us to run a range of events varying from Christmas and Easter to our annual church retreat. Event Logistics & Administration

The Event Logistics & Administration Team aim to ensure that everything related to finance and logistics runs smoothly for all our events.

Hospitality Area

The word hospitality in the Bible roughly translates as 'love for the stranger' and at its core is the way we welcome all people as Jesus has welcomed us! At SG Wahroonga we are committed to extending hospitality to all people who join our gatherings, whether they be visitors or members, whether it be a Sunday morning or an evening seminar.

Espresso Bar Team (10am & 5pm)

Men's Ministry

We live in an age where manhood is in crisis. Men are falling behind in literacy, entering university, overrepresented in our prisons (92% in Australia 2021) and increasingly told that masculinity is toxic. Our men's ministry exists to encourage, teach and train men to embrace their calling as men following Jesus.

Bible Study Leading

Mission

Music & Production Area

Every week the precious bride of Christ, God's family comes together to worship and grow in their knowledge of and love for him. Therefore, as a church we want to conduct our services in a way that magnifies the Lord Jesus to the best of our ability! The music and production team consists of several smaller service teams.

Digital Media (Video / Photography / Web Design / Graphic Design)

We live in an age where billboards and bulletins are relics of the past. Now the primary window outsiders have into our community is our digital presence. We want to make this presence as appealing as possible to those interested in joining us.

Music Team (10am & 5pm)

At SG Wahroonga we're passionate about worshipping the Lord with everything we've got! So when it comes to our Sunday singing or youth and kids gatherings we're always looking for musicians and singers who are interested in being a part!

PA Team (10am & 5pm)

If you love good music this is the ministry for you! Each week our sound team works to set–up and fine–tune our PA to make the band sound their best! You don't need any experience to join this team because we'd love to train you!

Projector & Livestream (10am & 5pm)

If you've ever found yourself mumbling the words to a Christian song because you're not quite sure of the lyrics than you'll understand how important this ministry is! This team oversees all our visual media on a Sunday morning including our YouTube livestream.

Service Coordination Area

The service coordination team oversees the smooth running of all the logistics required to make a Sunday service happen. This ranges from putting out the chairs, mobilising volunteers and general problem solving.

Chief Steward Team (10am & 5pm)

The chief steward is responsible for the smooth running of all the logistics around a Sunday service. They oversee all of our Sunday morning volunteers, and they are the main contact to problem solve any challenges that may occur.

Set-up & Support Team (10am & 5pm)

As we are meeting in a rented facility, we set up each week before church. This involves setting up the chairs and banners, and, assisting any of the other teams that might need some extra help. Coming before the service to set-up is actually a great time to enjoy our community before church and meet new people. We're always looking for volunteers so please let us know if you can help!

SG Kids Area

We believe that learning about God should be an engaging and fun experience. God is not boring and we don't want our kids to think that He is! SG Kids runs a program for all ages, that includes all the things that kids love - games, crafts, teaching, and music, all housed in a fun, informal environment. We have a thriving kids ministry that includes several teams: Babies Team (6-18 m.o), Toddlers Team (18m.o-3yrs), Adventurers Team (3yrs-Kindy), Builders Team (Kindy-Year 2) and Conquerors Team (Year 3-6).

Due to the size of our kids work we encourage parents who are utilizing the ministry to serve on the roster. There are two roles that exist within SG Kids:

Teacher (10am & 5pm)

A teacher is someone responsible for a given classroom on a Sunday morning. They are someone of proven character, who loves teaching kids about Jesus.

Assistant (10am & 5pm)

An assistant is someone who assists with the running of a classroom on a Sunday morning. They aid the teacher in implementing the curriculum and are an extra set of hands to help the morning run smoothly (e.g. preparing the craft activity, liaising with parents where necessary etc.).

SG Youth

SG exists to help youth know Jesus, have a lasting relationship with Jesus and to help parents encourage youth to be mature followers of Jesus. Meeting at the SG Offices, SG Youth is the place to be on a Friday night for everyone in years 7-12. Running every week during term time, SG Youth combines solid teaching with passionate worship, games and the opportunity to just hang out.

Youth Leader

Youth Mentor

We run a youth mentoring program for interested youth in years 9–12. The aim is for youth to grow in the depth of their relationships within the church and in any specific area of their choosing. The mentoring program is usually limited to one term at a time only.

Welcome Team (10am & 5pm)

Kids Welcome Team (10am & 5pm)

When new families join us on a Sunday morning often their first interaction is with those serving at the kids welcome desk. This is a space for those passionate about helping kids and parents feel welcomed to our services and to get connected with our kids ministry!
